HEAT TREATMENT INSTRUCTIONS

TMPC will not be responsible for any cash or valuables left behind during treatment

Items customer **SHOULD** prepare prior to treatment.

Please check off once completed. All Items listed below must be removed from treatment area.

- □ **ALL** closets need to be emptied and clear of clutter.
- Dresser drawers need to be emptied and cleared of all clutter.
- Clean clothes should be inspected then bagged and placed outside of the treatment area.
- □ Remove ALL clutter from treatment area.
- □ Picture frames need to be removed from wall and placed on the ground below. We will be using fans that will blow pictures off the wall.
- □ Loose papers need to be secured. The fans will cause loose papers to fly around.
- Area rugs must be inspected and removed from treatment area.
- □ Remove Persons, plants and animals (THIS INCLUDES AQUARIUMS)
- Animals should be taken to a veterinarian and checked & bathed the day of treatment.
- □ Remove or place in refrigerator Candles, wax items, crayons, deodorant, lipstick and other cosmetics and items that may liquefy.
- □ Remove Guns and Ammo. (ammo may lose it's potency)
- Remove "Vinyl" plastic items like mini blinds and vinyl records and VHS Tapes (they may warp)
- □ Remove Aerosol cans and all other combustible items.
- □ Magnets (like those used to hold notes on refrigerators) Place on counter or in refrigerator.
- □ Fresh fruits and vegetables, chocolates, carbonated beverages, **wine** and other liquors, artificial sweeteners, vitamins and medicines. (These items may be placed in refrigerator)
- □ Remove Antiques if antiques cannot be removed; contact your TMPC representative for special treatment options.
- Remove all face plates on electrical outlets so we can place a residual dust in the voids.
- Remove all cigarette lighters, including the long lighters for candles and barbeques.
- All areas should be cleaned, ensuring excessive dust, dirt, pet hair, etc. are removed.

Special Note: Laminate floors and Laminate furniture are heat sensitive. They may buckle and/or the laminate may peel. Cabinet doors with Thermofoil should be removed from the cabinets – this is a vinyl material and will peel. TMPC is not responsible for damage that may occur.

Items that **SHOULD NOT** be removed from treatment sites:

- 1. Beds, dressers, couches and chairs.
- 2. All electronics: radios, TV's (including plasma & LCD), stereo systems, portable heaters should not be removed. **Special Note**: please do not turn electronics on for two hours after treatment is completed.
- 3. Disconnect or remove batteries from smoke detectors.
- 4. Musical instruments. Instruments may de-tune due to expansion and contraction.
- 5. Oil Paintings should be removed after inspection by technicians.

AFTER CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Please do not open vinyl windows or turn on the air conditioner or heater for at least two hours after the treatment. The structure should be allowed to cool down naturally. Please launder or dry clean a set of clothes, and then put them in a sealed plastic bag to put on just before leaving the property.
